In 2006, Don Tucker and Spectrum Contracting Services, Inc. was selected to contract a new family life center for the Harmony Christian Church. The project was an addition to Harmony's existing facility which was landlocked and a concern for the church leaders. During the discussions, the leadership expressed a desire to somehow accommodate their growing ministry through the practical relocation of their church. From their friendship and business relationship, Don Tucker knew that Jay Million had recently worked with the then Owners of the former Wal-Mart which was available for purchase. Through this unique turn of events and personal contacts, the facility was ultimately purchased by the church, along with the quick sale of the churches old property to the Scott County School Board. In a project that was required to be on a fast track because of the terms of the sales agreements in place, Million Architecture and Spectrum Contracting Services developed a design solution that accommodated an adaptive reuse that breathed a second life into a property that needed a second wind, and was constructed in less than 120 calendar days.
